

League Presidents and TOC Tournament Teams:

Mukilteo Little League is proud to host the 2018 Washington District 1 Baseball TOC Tournament. The tournament will start on May 29th and run through June 10th at the Mukilteo Little League fields at Paine Field Community Park.

### **TOURNAMENT INFORMATION**

- The tournament will be **DOUBLE ELIMINATION**.
- An updated tournament bracket will be posted on the bulletin board outside the snack shack and updated nightly on Mukilteo Little League's website.
- **Regular Season Little League Playing Rules** shall be in effect for the entire tournament.
  - Teams will utilize a 9 player batting order with substitutions (Rule 4.04).
    - *Continuous batting orders SHALL NOT be used.*
  - The 10 Run Rule (Rule 4.10 (e)) will be in effect after 4 innings (3 ½ if the home team is ahead).
  - The Batter's Box Rule (Rule 6.02 (c)) will be enforced. After entering the batter's box the batter must remain in the box with at least one foot throughout the at bat.
  - The use of "Pool Players" will not be allowed.
- Coaches must sign a pitching report with the official scorer after each game.
- Paine Field Community Park is located at 11928 Beverly Park Rd, Everett, WA 98204. Parking may be limited due to other League games going on simultaneously on other fields. Please lock your car and valuables.
- Mukilteo Little League has a full concession stand for your convenience.

### **TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES**

- Teams should plan to arrive no later than 45 minutes prior to game time. Managers should check-in with the tournament site host or Mukilteo LL Board Member at the tent located by the concession stand building.
- **Teams checking in must submit a roster, signed by their League President upon check-in to their first tournament game.** The tournament director will verify that participating teams have their medical releases at check-in prior to every game.
- The Home team will be determined by a coin toss with both managers at check-in. The team listed on the top line of the bracket will call the toss. The Home team will take the 3<sup>rd</sup> base dugout.
- Two copies of the line ups must be submitted upon conclusion of the coin toss
- Teams will be allowed to warm-up in designated areas only. Batting practice is only permitted in the warm-up area, Whiffle balls and/or popup nets only. Batters MUST wear a batting helmet.
- Visiting teams are to take their infield warmup 30 minutes before game time. Home teams are to take their infield warmup 20 minutes before game time. 10 minutes prior to game start time, the umpires and managers will conduct their plate meeting.
- Upon conclusion of plate meeting, teams will be announced in the order of the line-up card. Teams will form lines extending from the pitcher's mound.
- Upon conclusion of the game, teams eliminated from the tournament will remain on the field to exchange pins with the winning team. At the conclusion of all games, teams will form lines and shake hands.
- Prior to meeting with their teams at the end of games, Managers must promptly report to the registration tent to verify pitch counts and sign the pitch count records.
- Players and coaches are asked to respect the rule set forth by Mukilteo Little league. This includes the following:
  - Dugout gates are to remain closed at all times while play is occurring.
  - Coaches must remain in the dugouts during play (exception: base coaches).
  - All players, coaches and spectators are expected to practice good sportsmanship at all times and may be removed at the League's discretion.
