Hello Baseball Players,

Majors, Minors and Farm Assessments will be on Saturday, February 10<sup>th</sup>  
Assessments at Harbour Pointe Middle School located at 5000 Harbour Pointe Blvd,  
Mukilteo, WA 98275.

Make ups will be on Monday, February 12<sup>th</sup> in the evening. Please read the  
instructions thoroughly to assist in keeping assessments on schedule.

**Age Verification:** We are required by Little League International to verify age for  
each one of our players. If you have received an email asking for proof of age/birth  
certificate, and not yet provided one, please bring a certified copy to tryouts.

**Special Note:** The number of teams in each division will be based on the number of  
kids registered in each division, team sizes, number of coaches, and assessment  
results. It is possible, once assessments are concluded, that we will need to move  
kids around based on the above noted factors. We will make every effort to assign  
players to the division for which they registered and in which their skills and  
development are best suited.

- Assessments will occur RAIN OR SHINE.
- You must attend assessments in order to be eligible for the draft.
- You must come at your assigned individual time slot in order to be seen by  
the coaches for the division you are trying out. Due to the large number of  
kids and tight schedule, there can be few exceptions. If you absolutely cannot  
attend at the assigned time, contact: [Registrar@mukilteolittleleague.com](mailto:Registrar@mukilteolittleleague.com)  
immediately.
- You have been assigned a group number for your specific time slot. Groups  
will consist of 6 players in each group and will take 15 minutes. Do not lose  
or forget your group number.
- Arrive 30-40 minutes before your specific time slot to allow enough time to  
check in and warm up. For example, if your time slot is at 11:00, plan to  
arrive at 10:20-10:30. If you arrive late and miss your slot, there are no  
guarantees about when we can fit you in, so don't be late!

- Upon arrival, check in at the registration table under the tent. You will be given a ticket with your group number on it and a pinney to wear during assessments. The pinney is very important as it is the only way for the coaches to identify you on the score sheets.
- What to bring:
  - Baseball Glove
  - Cleats
  - Bat (if you have one) ***Special note: USA Label only***
  - Helmet (if you have one)
  - Warm clothes and rain jacket
  - Umbrella
  - Patience and good attitude!
  - Note: Old baseball clothes, cleats, gloves, batting gloves, etc. can be dropped off at the registration desk and will be available to kids who need them or sent to Panama.
- You will warm up on in the designated area after check in.
- Each ball player will perform and be assessed on the following skills:
  - Catching fly balls
  - Fielding ground balls (proper fundamentals, accuracy)
  - Throwing
  - Hitting and/or bunting (stance, form, focus and contact)
  - Running (speed and focus)
- After you are assessed, you must return your pinney to the check-in station. If you do not return your pinney, you will not be placed in the draft.
- What is expected of parents is patience and understanding. We are all volunteers and the MLL Code of Conduct will be adhered to.
